



NOTICE TO MARINERS NO. 3/17

Upper Severn Estuary – Slimeroad Sand.

Refer to British Admiralty chart no. 1166 (A & B)

Mariners are advised that the shoal area identified in Notice No. 2/17 has dissipated.

The drying height of the “tail” of Slimeroad Sand west of $2^{\circ}38'.20W$ is presently observed to be 2₆. Drying heights east of $2^{\circ}38'.20W$ are presently estimated to be greater than 3₅.

Depths in this area frequently change and may be less than charted. Attention is thus drawn to the need for vessels (particularly those expecting to arrive at Sharpness with minimum underkeel clearance) to continue to exercise considerable caution whilst transiting this area.

Notice No. 2/17 is hereby cancelled

Owners, Agents and Charterers should ensure that the contents of this Notice are made known to the Masters or persons in charge of their vessels or craft.
