



NOTICE TO MARINERS NO. 5/15

River Wye, Chepstow

Maintenance work, Chepstow Town Bridge

Mariners are advised that essential maintenance work on Chepstow Town Bridge is likely to continue until the end of the year.

The scaffolding installed beneath the bridge is placed in such a way that at least one bridge span remains available for the passage of small craft throughout the period of the work.

Flashing amber beacons (six in number) are installed on the scaffolding at a height of approximately MHWS plus 1m to indicate the presence of the obstruction.

River users are therefore requested to proceed with caution and pass only beneath the unencumbered bridge span(s) in order to avoid risk of damage to vessels and/or suspended scaffolding.
