



NOTICE TO MARINERS NO. 6/22

(Small Craft Notice)

River Wye, Tintern

Maintenance work, Tintern Wireworks Bridge

Mariners are advised that, commencing from mid-end July 2022 (exact date to be confirmed), essential maintenance work is to commence on Tintern Wireworks Bridge. This will involve the installation of a scaffolding structure around and beneath the bridge for the entire span of the river. Works are expected to take approximately 8-9 months.

Though passage for small craft will still be possible throughout the period of the work, available air draft will be reduced by approximately 1.5 metres. The lower extremity of the scaffold structure will be marked by a yellow flashing light in the centre of the bridge.

River users are therefore requested to proceed with caution and pay due regard to tidal height in relation to the reduced air draft in order to avoid risk of damage to vessels and/or suspended scaffolding.
